"Wild Weekends"

From March through October you are invited to join our "Wild Weekends" with free-of-charge days of activity and brief lectures on animals, plants and nature conservation held at the Wilhelma School.

Free Guided Tours

The **Wilhelma attendants**, trained members from the Association of the Friends and Patrons of the Wilhelma, impart interesting facts about the animals and plants kept at the Wilhelma and the history of the Zoological-Botanical Garden.

Dates: April – October. Saturdays, 02.00 pm, Sundays and public holidays 10.30 am and 02.00 pm Duration: about 90 minutes Where? At the "Meeting Spot Guided Tours" in front of the Winter Garden Reservations: not required; participation is always possible.

Open to you every day of the year

The main entrance and the animal and plant houses open daily at 08.15 am. The Aquarium, Amazonian House, Terra Australis, Insectarium, the Ape House, Small Mammal, Bird and Insectivore House, as well as the Elephant House, open at 09.00 am.
